Units: Population is measured in millions

Population growth is an annualized growth rate for the period 1980-1997.

GDP per capita is expressed in 1997 US dollars, converted at 3-year moving average exchange rates

Caloric intake is a daily per capita figure for 1989. (More recent figures are unavailable.)

Life expectancy is the expected age at death of a child born in 1997

Health expenditures are annual averages for the period 1990-1997, expressed in 1997 US dollars, converted at 3-year moving average exchange rates

Classifications:

low income: less than \$785 US in 1997

lower middle income: greater than \$785 US but less than \$3,125 US in 1997

upper middle income: greater than \$3,125 US but less than \$9,656 US in 1997

high income: greater than \$9,656 US in 1997
