Gene Grossman is the Jacob Viner Professor of International Economics in the Department of Economics and the Woodrow Wilson School of Public and International Affairs at Princeton University. He is a recipient of the Onassis Prize in International Economics and the Harry Johnson Prize from the Canadian Economics Association, a Fellow of the Econometric Society and of the American Academy of Arts and Sciences. He has written extensively on international economics. His books include *Innovation and Growth in the Global Economy* and *Interest Groups and Trade Policy* (both with Elhanan Helpman).
